On Friday, December 8<sup>th</sup>, the Lustre Christian Lions prepared for a tough battle against the Broadus Hawks. The Hawks were representatives of the southern division at the Class C State tournament last year, ending in fourth place among the eight teams attending. The Broadus Hawks were a solid team. They only had three Seniors the previous year and lost some talent, but they returned a lot of the roster from that state team.

The game tipped off at roughly 4:30, with both teams ready for a battle. The Broadus boys came out ready to play, leading 15-11 at the end of the first quarter. The Lions started slow, so they made it their goal to pick it up in the second quarter, which they

did. The halftime score was 37-25 in favor of the Lions. The Lions went into the locker room at halftime happy with the second quarter but still determined to keep pushing.

The Lions came out in the third quarter, erupting from almost everywhere on the floor. The Hawks didn't seem to have an answer for this run, and at the end of the third, it was 64-32, the Lions with a commanding lead. In the fourth, the Hawks outscored the Lions 16-14, but it wasn't enough, as the Lions won with a score of 78-48. The Lions had a combined score in the second and third quarters of



53 compared to the Hawks's 17. Scoring leaders for the Lions were Johnsee Pierre and Cayden Klatt, both with 22.

Aubri Holzrichter lit the fire from outside, nailing three 3s and ending with 13 points. Grace Brown worked the key, adding her nine points to the score. also contributed to the Lady's Lion's win with her two points. The Lustre Lions ended that Friday afternoon with the first win of the Scobey tournament. The final score of their game was 28-47.

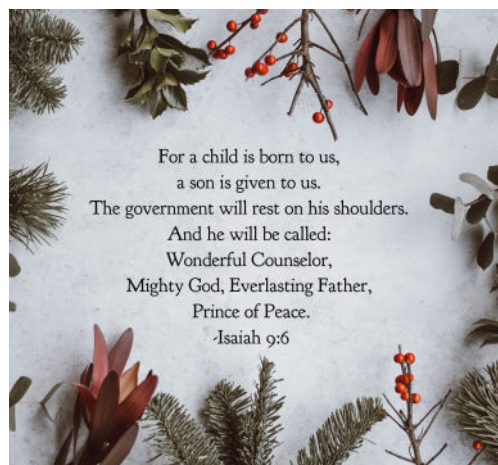
Christmas joy!
